3. The Swim Club Member releases Pinecrest and/or Kathleen Rosenow and Frank Spevacek from any liability while a guest at the Pinecrest pool. THERE IS NO LIFE GUARD AND SWIMMING IS AT YOUR OWN RISK.
4. By signing this Agreement the Swim Club Member Agrees to abide by the Pinecrest Pool Rules and Regulations (dated Summer 2010) that are attached to this agreement. These rules may be modified from time-to-time by Pinecrest.

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POOL RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Members are responsible for signing in the names of all members and guests when they arrive and prior to swimming or using the facilities. There is a sign-in notebook at the pool office.
2. No running or other disruptive behavior that may cause a hazardous condition.
3. No glass allowed in the pool or bathroom areas.
4. Anyone under the age of 18 years must be accompanied by their parent or designated member adult. Members who may appear under the age of 18 must provide proof of age upon request.
5. All food and beverages are to be consumed in the designated areas. Members are responsible for knowing these areas and cleaning up after use.
6. Members and their guests are restricted to the use of the pool area and main building restrooms.
7. Skateboarding is prohibited.
8. Members are responsible for the actions of any guests they bring.
9. All pool toys are subject to approval by the Pool Manager. Any pool activities that disrupt the use of the pool by other swimmers are prohibited.
10. All swimmers must be out of the pool before the posted pool closing time. Only adults may be present in the pool and deck area during adult swim hours.
11. Parents must supervise children while using the bathroom and shower areas. Every effort should be made to promote safety and water conservation.
12. All Federal, State and County laws are enforced within Pinecrest and violations of such could result in immediate expulsion from Pinecrest.
13. If there is any question about a child's toilet training, the child must wear Little Swimmers or similar quality protection. All children under 2 ½ yrs of age shall wear such protection.
14. Sunflower seeds or any other shelled nuts are prohibited.
15. Violation of these regulations may result in the revocation of the Swim Club Membership. Prepaid fees will be refunded on a prorated basis plus a \$25 service charge.
